The City of Helsinki as a summer employer



- The City of Helsinki is Finland's largest employer, employing over 37,000 professionals in various fields.
- Our professionals work in four different City divisions, public enterprises and the City's central administration.
- Together, we provide city residents with impactful services that make Helsinki an even better place to live.
- The City employs around a thousand young summer employees every summer.



The City's summer jobs

- The city employs around 700 young people of ages 16 to 17
 - There are jobs in many different fields and various positions
- Siisti kesä! project employs nearly 300 people between the ages 16 to 20
 - The jobs involve cleaning parks, streets and sports venues, for example
 - Over 18-year-olds can apply for team leader positions
- **Kesätyöseteli** is a project supported by the City that makes it easier to get summer jobs at companies, for example
 - The Summer Job Voucher is intended for 9th graders and those participating in preparatory education (TUVA)
- → These summer jobs are often organised in June and July

- For 16–20-year-olds
- Team leader positions for over 18-year-olds

Why work for the City?

- → Work experience: learn new skills while working on different tasks and get valuable work experience
- → Work community: the City offers supportive colleagues, a communityoriented working environment and a great induction to the job
- → Salary: the monthly salary for a full-time summer job is 1,100 euros
- → Benefits: lunch benefit and free-of-charge use of city bikes for the season, among other benefits
